Oklahoma GEAR UP (Gaining Early Awareness and Readiness for Undergraduate Programs), a federally funded program administered by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, partners with 13 school districts to provide college preparation services and information to

over 16,000 7th-12th grade students and their families.

GEAR UP also helps college freshmen who graduate from a GEAR UP school district with assistance in acclimating to college if they attend one of our five partnering colleges.


